Texas Pain & Spine Institute now requires that a urine drug screen be performed by all patients initially as a new patient and by all established patients on a random basis thereafter.

You may decline to perform this urine screen, but if you do so, your provider will NOT prescribe any medications for you; even if they have been prescribed in the past.

Only until the screen is performed will any prescriptions be released to you, the patient.

We will perform the initial preliminary urine drug screen here in the office and then it will be sent off to Millennium Health/Cornerstone Medical for final confirmation results.

We as Texas Pain & Spine will bill your insurance/you (if you are private pay) for the portion that is performed in our office. US Health Group will send you a separate bill for the testing sent out to the laboratory; which may be out of network with your insurance.
